## **Our Courses**

Below is a list of courses that are approved by the CPD service:

- The Synergy programme was developed with the Laskaridis Foundation in Greece. The unique focus of Synergy is on the mindset of the worker, the narrative around behaviours of concern and in reducing stress. The model is designed to boost and maintain skills locally through a mentor network.
- Health and social care professionals: We have a number of courses for Health Authorities and Local Authorities to meet their statutory obligations regarding autism training for their staff. One-day courses are delivered at intermediate and advanced levels. Further 'training the trainer' courses are available so that an Authority's own staff can deliver such training in-house.
- Approved Mental Health Professionals (AMHP): Workshop on understanding and responding to autism. A course for AMHPs to provide them with an overview on autism, co-occurring mental health conditions and how the relevant legislation affects practice.

- Working effectively with families: A course for professionals to understand the family journey and build positive relationships.
- Training the police: A series of short intensive training modules for police officers, probation officers, prisons personnel, lawyers, judges and other staff involved in justice, reflecting the different scenarios likely to be encountered in all parts of the CJS. Developed with the police and justice agencies - including autistic officers.
- Sexuality and relationship: A two-day course 'Safe, Healthy, Happy' covering autism, sexuality and relationships.
- Clinical practice in autism: Identification, diagnosis and support. This course is for healthcare professionals to receive an update on our current clinical knowledge of autism.
- SPELL: A framework for understanding and responding to autism developed with the Tizard University of Kent and Pavillion Publishing.
