The Social Model of Disability

The Social Model holds that a person isn't 'disabled' because of their impairment, health condition, or the ways in which they may differ from what is commonly considered the medical 'norm'. Rather it is mostly the physical and attitudinal barriers in society – prejudice, lack of access adjustments and systemic exclusion – that disable

people.













