SPELL In Care, my experience

- Structure (one size fits all).
- Positivity (yes and no service user vs public speaking).
- Empathy (they didn't know who I was).
- Links (care services, day centre or social services).
- Low Arousal (highly charged atmosphere/ being placed in situations that were causing me harm.

SPELL Organically happening



- Structure flexible routines Autism/ ADHD.
- Positivity I am validated in work (purpose).
- Empathy Cultural understanding and lack of understanding of autism going in my favour.
- Low Arousal I pick and choose what I do (within reason).
- Links At work I have employment rights,
 Union support, Reasonable adjustments,
 and access to everyday people.






